Be Still

He says, "Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth." – Psalm 46:10

There is a time I (Deb) have been neglecting. I used to set aside one morning a week just to listen to God. This is not daily devotion time, this is purposeful, listening to God time. I have gotten out of my normal routine. Last Tuesday, God placed it on my heart to begin again. I got my praise music, my Bible and my journal and I headed out onto the porch to be alone, just me and God. I began with praising Him and letting the lyrics of the worship music remind me how great our God is. After a few songs, I headed over to my journal and said, "Here I am God. I'm listening." No agenda, no list of things or people to pray for, just time to sit still in God's presence and listen. He began to bring things to the surface I did not realize were there. One by one, like a skilled surgeon, He showed me the sins in my heart I needed to repent. He began to cleanse my heart. He did it with such grace and love.

God used two sets of Scriptures to speak to me.

Jeremiah 29: 11-13 He told me He has great plans for us in Haiti. He helped me see I had doubts and fears about that. He said if we continued to seek Him with our whole hearts we would find Him, He would be with us, lead us. I repented of not trusting Him enough. A few tears began to flow but God dried them with His forgiveness. God's conviction with our repentance is always followed by His redemption and restoration. (1John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.)

1 John 2: 2-4 Here He reminded me how I have everything I need in this life through my salvation in Jesus Christ. His atoning sacrifice on the cross covers all my sins, it gives me power and strength. What can the world do to me? Take my life? I have eternal life in Jesus Christ! Then He reminded me of our part. We need to keep His commands. Yes, He promises so many



things to us but we must walk righteously by following His Word and doing what it says.

Why are we sharing all of this with you? To encourage you. We all go through difficult times and right now we are going through something big, a pandemic! Some people are out on the front lines, some have the illness. We lift them up today for strength and healing. Many of us are doing what we can by staying home. This is not easy but it does give us one special gift, time. We believe God is calling us to give Him some of that time. Be in His Word, praise Him, go to virtual church and Bible Study. Stay in fellowship with others. We know some people are doing these things already and that's good. If not, we encourage you to do so. We also want you to consider giving God some special TIME (Truly Intimate Moments to Examine your hearts before God). We have shared what TIME looks like for Deb. It may be completely different for you. What's most important is for you to take TIME to, "Be still, and know that He is God." Let Him speak to you through His Holy Spirit and His Word. Let Him reveal things to you, help you grow in your faith, repent, release fears, let go of past hurts, be restored, refreshed, loved, whatever work He wants to do in you. Let God help you grow closer to Him, learning to trust Him more as He speaks to your heart.

Father, we pray we would give You time. We pray we would be still and listen, to allow You to minister to our hearts and help us grow in our faith. God, let not any work You do in us be undone. As we go back to "normal", to schedules, busy lives, etc. we pray none of us would neglect You and slip back into our old ways. May we always make time for You. Amen.
